OPENING CEREMONY IN MITCHELL HALL

The Opening Ceremony officially begins IC 2017 at 7:45 PM in the Mitchell Hall Gymnasium. Doors open at 6:45 for seating. There will be open seating. Last year's slideshow will be shown at 7:25 PM.

This year's Opening Ceremony will include the traditional International Flag Procession. Flag bearers dress in costumes representing their country, region, or state, adding flair to the procession. A portion of each country's national anthem will be played as that nation's flag is carried to the stage.

THINGS TO KNOW AT IC:



PROBLEM SOLVING CENTRAL (PSC):

PSC is the place to answer all of your IC 2017 questions. Problem Solving Central is located in the New Student Center in the Lobby above the Entertainment Café. Check the IC Program for times.

NECK WALLET:

All participants must wear their neck wallets to all events. Replacement neck wallets are available for purchase (\$10) at Problem Solving Central.

TOURS:

If you reserved a tour through HMI, please be at the Recreational Eagle Center Parking Lot at least 15 minutes prior to your scheduled departure time. Departure times will be posted at the HMI travel desk. No refunds will be made if you miss the bus.

ZIPPY MART:

The Zippy Mart is located and open for business in the Entertainment Café located in the New Student Center during posted times.

SECURITY:

University Police Services are on duty during IC. UWL Police: 608-789-9000

QUIET HOURS:

Out of respect for others, please observe "quiet hours" in sleeping areas between 11:00 PM and 6:30 AM. Chaperones are asked to enforce the quiet hours, particularly on Thursday night since competitors must get up bright and early on Friday morning.

BEHAVIOR:

Coaches and chaperones are responsible for student behavior and well-being. IC participants are expected to conduct themselves maturely and appropriately. Use of alcohol, illegal drugs, smoking, destructive behavior to either person or property, or any action that might endanger others will not be tolerated.

FIRE ALARMS:

The residence halls must be evacuated in the event of a fire alarm. A prank fire alarm not only risks lives, it also costs thousands of dollars and is a violation of state law.

ROOM KEYS & ACCESS CARDS:

Lost keys can be replaced at residence hall desks. The person listed as responsible for payment during IC registration will receive a bill for the replacement. **Replacement Key = \$90.**

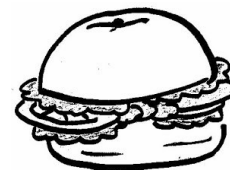

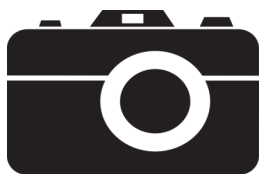
