## OPENING CEREMONY HIGHLIGHTS

Marianne Solomon, Executive Director of FPSPI, began the Opening Ceremony with a warm welcome to all 2017 IC participants. Justin Lightfoot, from the Iowa FPS Program, announced each flag bearer for the traditional Flag Procession.

Mark Sandheinrich, the Interim Dean at The University of Wisconsin's College of Science and Health, welcomed everyone to the UWL campus and emphasized the importance of being creative, lifelong learners.

Lexi Cadieu, a brand new FPSPI staff member and former FPS competitor, presented the opening ceremony's keynote address. She spoke of the competition's dedicated members, their diversity, and their unity that once gave her strength in her own events in 2009.
